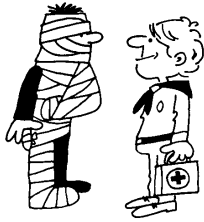
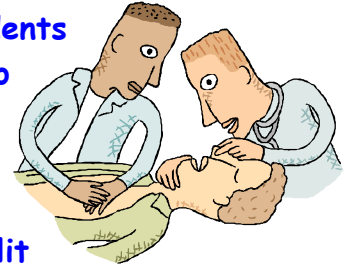


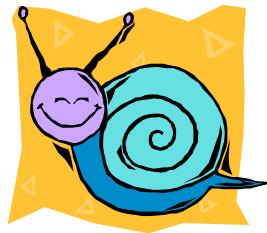
The first week in Feb we completed some first aid training, the Cubs were taught and practiced the Recovery position, controlling bleeding and basic bandages.



The following week, five medical students came from Liverpool University, to teach us how to do CPR. First they demonstrated it using a Resusi Annie doll, then they broke it down into steps / stages and finally they asked us to tell them how to do it. Then we were split into 5 groups and each medical student took one group with a Resusi Annie and every Cub practiced the CPR they had been taught. When everyone had had a go we came back together for one final run through to check they all learnt the procedure, very thorough!



After a half term break we came together for a Bug Box night, split into two sessions, the Beavers and some of the Cubs came to the first session, everyone sat in a circle on chairs and Roger began. He has a 'Bug Box' and each time some of the Beavers and Cubs helped him to open the box and get the Bugs out. On each occasion after Roger had told us a



bit about the bug, those who wanted to, were able to carefully handle it, those who didn't just had a look. We saw various Stick Insects, a Scorpion, a very
