

On 1st February we did more First Aid work. This covered how to deal with minor bleeding and how to make a successful 999 call, with an observation activity game where the Cubs had to remember details and then answer questions about accident scenarios

The following week four medical students from Liverpool University came and taught us CPR. Firstly they demonstrated each stage and asked us to remember each step and then we were split into small groups and everyone had the chance to practice on a Resucci Annie doll - Adam Gooseman completed and was awarded his Personal Safety Activity badge.
