To round up our year we went bowling and laser questing at New Brighton which was loads of fun and enjoyed by all!



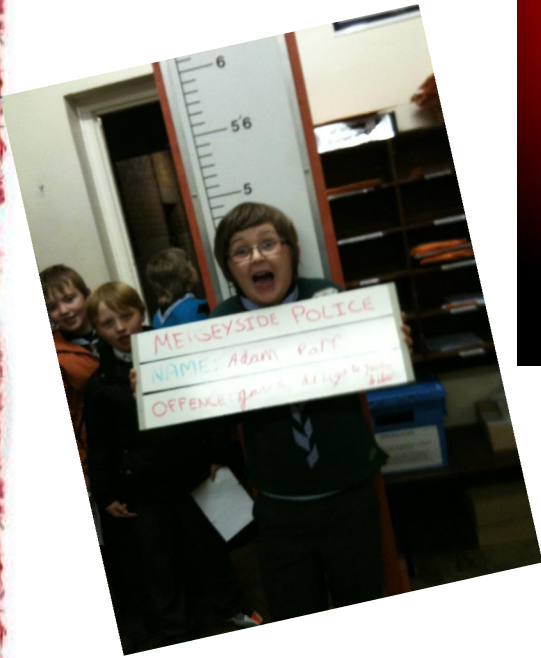
