Treasurer Notes AGM 26thJune2020

Hello,

Just to confirm the accounts have been audited and signed off. They will be available to view on the charity commission website, or if you would like a copy drop me an email or a text and I will send one through.

Just to give a brief overview, we have 2 accounts:

Treasurers account, which pays the bills and matches off with the subs etc.

And the,

Activities account, which the parents pay into for all the wonderful trips and events you do with your groups, the trips are then paid out of this account. So this financial year we paid £41,675.81 we received £39,705.94, so we spent a little more than we received.

The treasurers account received:

£18073.20 in subs

£2500.00 in donations - Thank you very much.

£3374.93 in scout post.

Out of that we pay:

£8298.00 for our annual membership to National HQ

£1000 rent for the hut

£3619.40 in various types of insurance

£5148.12 for maintenance and repairs for the hut, this year we replaced all the windows and transformed the porch.

£3969.73 on equipment (cool boxes, storm pegs, a saw, a projector, a laptop) etc

Also, electricity, water, maintenance of the mini bus etc

This time last year we had an overall balance of £34,831.3	8 and now we have a balance of
£34,580.38	

So a little worse off but not much.

Looking forward into the financial year of 20/21 we have yet again opted not to increase subs. This is reviewed annually and we will let you know when we do.
