Merseyside County Scouts Annual Patrol Leader Training weekend took place at Waddecar this year and we had 8 Scouts representing West Wirral from the 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Heswall and 1<sup>st</sup> Newton troops. All Scouts were a real credit to their troops and to West Wirral. They enjoyed leadership training activities as well as shooting, a night hike, a quiz night and the chance to take part in the County Forum to have their say in shaping the future of Scouting as part of #YouShape month.



In February, we have launched two new competitions for the Scout section: The West Wirral Challenges 2018 and the Wirral 3 Peaks. Both events run from  $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$  February -  $\mathbf{30}^{\text{th}}$  November so troops can take part during the year at a time that fits in with your programme.

The Wirral 3 Peaks is an all-day hike and troops will be timed, plus are required to take photographs at specific points along the route. The West Wirral Challenges is a series of 15 challenges that can be completed by troops. They vary from fun indoor activities to outdoor challenges. All challenges have instructions provided and are badge linked to the Scout programme.

We hope to see some interesting and engaging challenges from the troop over the year and in December we will hold an all new Super Stars evening which will include prize giving and the results of both new competitions.


